Welcome to the first newsletter for the Chester Bus Interchange project.

The work commenced on 28th September 2015 and will be complete by 12th December 2016.

In the early stages of the contract, the works will consist of carrying out services diversions along Brook Street, Gorse Stacks, and Oulton Place. We will also be forming an additional carriageway on St Oswald's way from the Brook Street roundabout.

The demolition of the Ship Victory Public House is planned for October as is the Archaeological survey works on the existing Gorse Stacks car park site.
