What is the purpose of the role?

What does it involve?

- Operating a simple till (you will be fully trained in this)

- Working with the shop team to ensure the shop is a happy and atmospheric place to be for customers

- The ability to work with people from different backgrounds
- A passion for CLIC Sargent's work and the ability to speak about our work to others (you will be given all the information you need)

- The opportunity to develop your customer service skills
- Working with a great team of people at an exciting time of the year
