The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 33 and 35 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (“the 1984 Act”), the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on 7 May 2021 and may be cited as the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places, Ellesmere Port) (Hope Farm Road (Randle Meadow) Variation) Order 2021.
2. The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places, Ellesmere Port) Order 2013 is hereby varied as follows:
 - 2.1 Schedule 7 (McGarva Way Car Park) is deleted;
 - 2.2 New Schedule 9 below is inserted in respect of Hope Farm Road (Randle Meadow) Car Park.
